What is it?

ANTE: Abstracts in New Technologies and Engineering is a database that indexes technological and engineering innovations and includes US patents back to 1971.

Abstracts are available from January 1993 to the present. Sources covered include over 350 periodicals, conference proceedings, technical reports, trade journal/newsletter items, patents, and books.
