



What is it ?

Compendex® is the most comprehensive interdisciplinary engineering database in the world. Compendex contains over 9 million records and references over 5,000 international engineering sources including journal, conference, and trade publications. Coverage is from 1969 to present and the database is updated weekly.

How to use it:

Quick Search is the default option. It offers efficient and sophisticated information retrieval. Search terms are entered in the query form and can be focused on fields selected from a comprehensive range within the records.

To begin with the **subject/title/abstract** search is recommended. Search fields can also be linked with the Boolean operators AND, OR, NOT to provide very precise results. References received can be limited to journal articles or conference papers if so desired, or to a specific time period.

The **Browse Indexes** and **Thesaurus** features assist in identifying search terms which can be profitably applied to your search strategy. **Search tips** to increase the range and accuracy of your results are prominently displayed below the query form. **Help** explains the many topics and functions incorporated in this excellent resource. Users can easily save searches and create email alerts – this will forward new records matching your search directly to your email account.
