



### What is it?

ScienceDirect offers more than one quarter of the world's scientific, technical and medical information online, including:

- Over 2,000 peer reviewed journals
- Hundreds of book series, handbooks and reference works
- Many journals going all the way back to the first issue

### How to use it:




The front page of ScienceDirect provides links to all the main functions provided by this database.

- You can search for books or journal articles by using words from the title of the book, journal or individual article. You can also search for a particular issue of a journal or the issues from a particular year.

It's also possible to carry out a more advanced search.

- It is possible to browse the resources available by main subject area. These can also be broken down into more particular subject areas.

There are three different levels of access to these resources denoted by the following icons:

 = subscribed     = non-subscribed     = free

There is full access to those resources that are either free or subscribed to by the Institute. Those that are non-subscribed will still give access to tables of contents and abstracts of the articles.

- You can access abstracting databases subscribed to by DIT. At the moment Medline is the only one of these available.
- Registering with ScienceDirect allows you to keep track of your favourite resources. You can also set up alerts which will notify you if one of your stored searches yields new results.



- To help you get the most from ScienceDirect there are various online tutorials. You can also access the ScienceDirect infosite at <http://www.info.sciencedirect.com/> which has information on the coverage and usage of the resource.
