

Theatre in Video

Theatre in Video contains more than 250 definitive video performances of the world's leading plays, together with more than 100 film documentaries, all available online in streaming video. **Theatre in Video** contains works representing hundreds of leading playwrights, actors and directors. This collection also includes the complete works of Shakespeare as produced by the BBC as well as other production companies. With live television broadcasts of New York productions from the '50s, revivals of classic works and experimental performances from the '60s and '70s, as well as important contemporary performances, **Theatre in Video** covers a wide range of 20th century theatre history. The plays in **Theatre in Video** are actual original productions, captured and recorded while performed for a live theatre audience.

Accessing Theatre in Video:


1. **Theatre in Video** database can be accessed in different ways. Start at the library home page - <http://www.dit.ie/library> - Click "databases" from the options box on the left side of the screen; Scroll to **Theatre in Video** and click to open. Or, starting at the library home page, click "subject gateways" from the options box on the left of the screen; Then scroll to "Drama"; Click "Subject Databases"; click **Theatre in Video**.

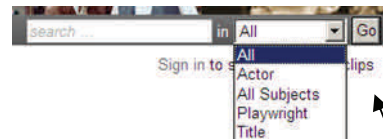
2. You need a PIN (personal identification number) to access **Theatre in Video** database content from home.

Help: Help is accessed via a link at the top of the web pages.

Searching Theatre in Video:

Simple Search:

A simple search is available from each **Theatre in Video** web page in the top right hand corner. For example, entering "Shaw" in the search box and "Go" to search "All" videos relating to Shaw would be retrieved. Clicking onto a title brings up a description of the video including a video "screen" where the video can be watched if it is what the user was looking for. One can also click  to play the video.



Advanced/Refined Search:

A more specific search is also available. Clicking "Advanced Search" at the top of any screen, or "Refine your search" after a simple search as above opens a much more detailed search form allowing for searching Title, Keyword, Actor, Director, Playwright, All Subjects, Company, Publisher, Theatre, and Date.

Users may also narrow searches by choosing the type of video — Productions or Documentaries.

Users may also narrow searches by choosing the type of video to watch—Productions or Documentaries. E.G. using the advanced search users can search for an English performance of Shakespeare: Choose **Shakespeare** as the **playwright** and click “select terms” for “**Company**”. A list of companies can be searched at once. Choosing a number of English companies and narrowing results to **Productions**, the following is retrieved. Users need only click one of the “Play” icons to watch a video in its entirety, or watch different individual acts.

Browsing Theatre in Video:

Users can browse videos in this database in the following categories: Productions; Documentaries; All People; Director; Playwright; Genres; Companies; Theatres, Dates, Subjects or Clips. People can be sorted by occupation as well—Actor, Performer, Choreographer, Conductor, Costume designer, Lighting designer, Musician, Set designer, Stage manager, etc.

To browse, users can click into the “Browse” icon in the top of the **Theatre in Video** web pages, then click a category to browse in.

Playlists:

Users can create personal playlists of clips, and also share those clips with other users on the site. There are also editorially selected themed playlists for users to browse. The playlists can be accessed by clicking the “Playlists” icon on the top of the web pages, or by clicking the My Playlists link.

Playlists

Playlists are themed collections of materials and can be created by any user of the database. Users can create playlists containing whole videos, tracks, segments (clips) and/or other items such as links to any URL. Playlists can be annotated, edited, copied, shared, and all playlists contain their own unique static URL. Playlists can be used as lists of personal favorites, class viewing/listening assignments, or as a teaching resource for in-class use.

The My Playlists tab contains a user's personal playlists, and are only visible to individual users.
