

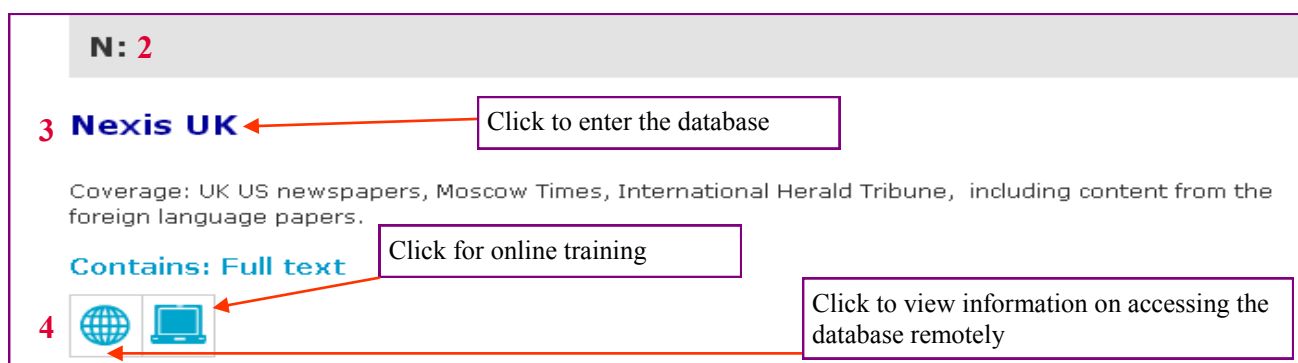
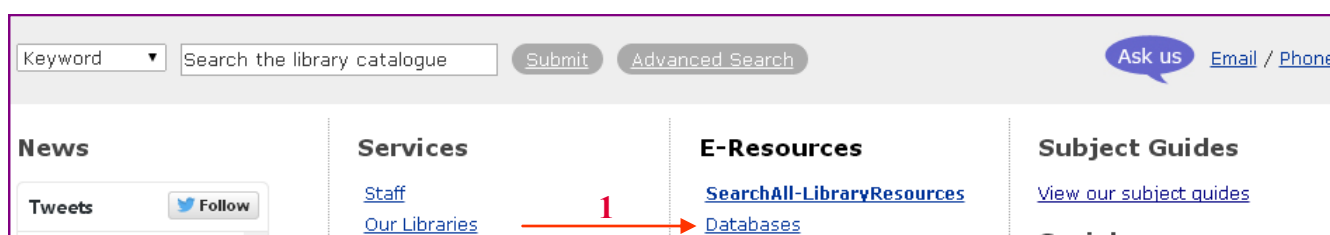
# Finding Foreign Language News on Nexis UK

## What is Nexis UK?

The Nexis UK database provides full text access to a wide range of newspapers, newswires and trade publications from around the world; e.g. *Der Spiegel*, *El Pais*, *Die Welt*, *Le Figaro*, *L'Express*, *La Stampa* and the *Berliner Morgenpost*.

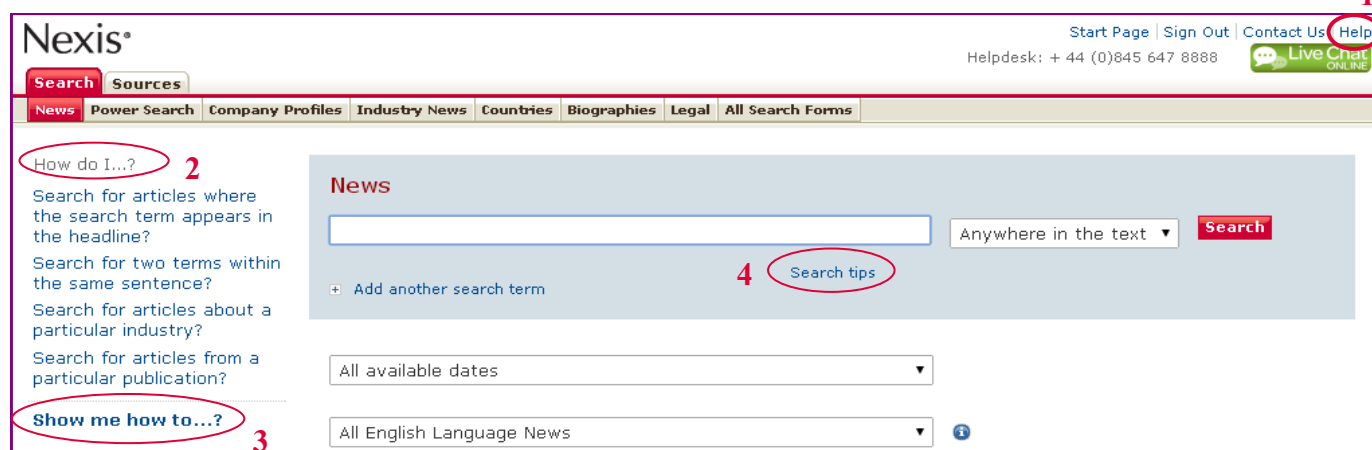
## Accessing Nexis UK

1. Click on the Databases link on the DIT library homepage (<http://www.dit.ie/library/>).
2. Click on the letter **N**, from the alphabetical listing, at the top of the next screen which brings you the list of databases beginning with N, or scroll down the screen.
3. Click on **Nexis UK** to search the database.
4. To access the database remotely (e.g. at home) you will need your student/staff number and library PIN.

## Basic Search Example

1. You can make a search as simple or as complex as you wish.
2. Type in your search term(s)/keyword(s) in the Search Term boxes below; e.g. Angela Merkel, ECB.
3. Select a connector when you have more than 1 search term; e.g. And.
4. Choose an option from the select a document drop-down menu; e.g. Anywhere in the text.
5. Select a Date option from the drop-down menu; e.g. Previous 3 months.

6. Select your news source from the Select Sources drop-down list; e.g. German Language News. Click on the source information icon to view list of news sources available for this particular search. You can select 1 or more specific sources from the list.
7. You can opt to exclude certain news sources from your search; in this example all non-business news has been excluded.
8. Click Search.
9. Click on the Power Search tab for more specific advanced search options.
10. Click on the Sources tab to search/find information on a specific newspaper title; e.g. *Le Figaro*.

## Viewing Your Search Results

1. This search retrieved 41 results/hits.
2. From the search results screen, you can choose to export all your results via email, send them to the cloud, save them on a USB key, export bibliographical references, share the search.
3. Click on a result to read/print etc the article.
4. Scroll down to a result that you want to read; e.g. result number 11 out of 41.
5. You can Search within results.

6. Click on an option on the left hand side of the results screen to view results from a particular group only; e.g. Publication. Click on the + sign to view additional result options.
