The Dublin Waste to Energy facility scheduled for completion this year will treat up to 600,000 tonnes of waste annually providing electricity for up to 80,000 homes and district heating for more than 50,000 homes. The Facility is the result of a public private partnership between Dublin City Council and Covanta but the design, project and construction management are being undertaken by PM group.
